	<p><b>(b) Friends &amp; Family – themes</b> – There are no negatives themes. For the new patient monitoring Kerry highlighted that some patients are registering with us as they have moved into the area and it is the nearest GP surgery.</p> <p>Kerry handed out a summary of the latest results from the National GP Patient Survey (Jan-March 2017). A discussion took place around the comparison between our practice results compared with national results and the fact that in most areas of the survey our results are higher than the national results. It was agreed to display a summary of this information in the waiting room.</p> <p><b>(c) Federation Update</b> – Dr. Darji informed the group that across South Charnwood there is an initiative called Practice Pharmacists whereby a Surgery employs a community pharmacist. It is a government funded initiative and has been a low uptake in South Charnwood. Another initiative being considered by Surgeries is ‘extended hours’. This involved opening weekends and evenings. South Charnwood want to use local premises but the CCG want to use Loughborough Hospital. The Federation is negotiating a way forward with the CCG to enable this new service to be available.</p>	Kerry
